### LESSON OVERVIEW

What do you want to be when you grow up? That's a question even adults ask themselves. In this lesson you'll explore six career types and learn a lot about yourself in the process.

### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

1. Discuss personality career types and select one to identify with.
2. Complete the *O\*NET Interest Profiler* to learn about your own career type.
3. Write a self-promotion.
4. Write a peer review of a self-promotion.
5. Compose a reflection of the results of the career profile.

There are two assignments in this lesson. One is to write a self-promotion using the information you learn about yourself after completing the *Interest Profiler*. In the second assignment you will reflect on the result of your *Interest Profiler*.

### Here are the ways you can succeed in this lesson.

1. Take appropriate initiative in discussion to demonstrate understanding of different personality types.
2. Thoroughly complete the *Interest Profiler* and carefully analyze the results.
3. Write an engaging self-promotion that demonstrates understanding of the career profile.
4. Present a thoughtful peer review of the self-promotion.
5. Thoughtfully reflect on the career profile and thoroughly address all questions, demonstrating understanding of the Holland's career types.



## ASSIGNMENT 1

In class you should have participated in a discussion about the six different personality and career types and you should have completed your own *Interest Profiler* and begun to analyze the result.

Think about your career type as you write a self-promotion of 150-200 words. The self-promotion may be for one of the following.

- an online dating service,
- “help wanted” website or
- contest entry application for the reality TV show of your choice

When you have finished, you will exchange your work with another classmate for a peer review.

When you get your work back, carefully review the comments, and revise and edit your work to address them.

Then proofread your work, polish it, and use the *Sakai* Assignments Tool to submit it for evaluation.



## ASSIGNMENT 2

In class you have explored Holland’s six career types, completed the *O\*NET Interest Profiler*, and written a self-promotion. Think about all of this as you reflect on the following.

**1<sup>st</sup> paragraph** Provide a summary of your Holland type and what it might mean for your future education and vocational pursuits. Use the type descriptions to help in your summary.

**2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph** Provide a summary of the information about the jobs you found that interest you.

**3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph** Provide a summary of any other jobs that you discovered in your search.

**4<sup>th</sup> paragraph** Describe possible jobs you are interested in exploring.

Then proofread your work, polish it, and use the *Sakai* Assignments Tool to submit it for evaluation.

Multiply the points by the weighted score and record in the total column for each rubric. Then tally the total points for the final score.
